

Tools Required

- 10mm, 7/16" Socket
- Flat Head Screwdriver



1. Using a 10mm socket, remove the 4x bolts located on top of the grille.
2. Carefully pry on the top of the grille to allow access to the clips securing the bottom.



3. With step 2, push on the top of the 4 self-locking tabs allowing the grille to be removed.
4. Using snips, remove some material from the bridge of the grille. Keep test fitting the light until a proper fit is achieved.




5. Using the supplied spacer and brackets, attach the brackets to the light bar as shown.
6. Using the supplied M6 bolt, attach the light to the back of the grille as pictured. Ensure the light is centered in the slot and the desired angle is achieved.




7. Plug in the up-fitter harness to the light bar. Route the wiring as shown.




8. Behind the battery, locate the fuse box and chassis ground. Underneath the fuse block is the upfitter (auxiliary) wires. Find the brown wire (15A, Aux 4 switch), and set aside.



9. Remove the fuse box lid and the 15 amp fuse from slot 33 (Vehicle Power). Refer to the lid for fuse locations. Place the 15 amp fuse into the fuse tap shown.




10. Separate the wires on the up-fitter harness. Each wire corresponds as shown.




11. Remove the splice connector from the green wire.



12. Place the brown up-fitter wire into the splice connector attached to the white wire and close the plastic housing. Connect the fuse tap to the green wire with the female side of the bullet connector. Apply heat to the clear heat shrink to protect the bullet connectors.



13. Attach the ground ring terminal to the chassis ground. Reinstall the fuse lid and front grille.



14. Now your front light bar will be powered by auxiliary switch #4 and the back-lighting feature will be powered with the key in the on position.



Tie all wires away from sharp, hot, and/or rotating components.

Re-torque all the fasteners after 100 miles.
