# FERRARI XB LED TAIL LIGHTS INSTALL GUIDE

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### TOOLS REQUIRED

8MM DEEP SOCKET OR WRENCH 10MM DEEP SOCKET OR WRENCH PHILIPS HEAD SCREWDRIVER POWER DRILL 7/32" OR 5.5MM DRILL BIT PAINTERS TAPE OR MASKING TAPE MARKER OR PEN



### INSTALLATION PROCESS

1. Using the 10mm deep socket or wrench, remove the three bolts holding each panel in place. Remove panels and set aside.



2. Using a 7/32" or 5.5mm bit, drill out the two rivets holding the third brake light grille trim panel to the car.





#### 3. Remove these four philips head screws and set aside.



4. Gently pull the top grille strip away from the car (to access the third brake light connector).



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5. Press the tab on the third brake light connector and remove it from the lamp assembly.



6. Remove these two 8mm bolts and set aside.





7. From the engine bay, remove these five (5) 8mm nuts and washers and set aside. Then remove the grille.



8. Using the painters tape or masking tape and pen, label the four OEM tail lights' locations.







10. Remove the two (2) 10mm nuts on each tail light. These will not be reused for the new tail lights.



11. Fit the provided rubber gasket into the channel on the light. Using the 10mm deep socket or wrench, remove and re-thread the studs on the back of the tail lights to match the factory stud placement. This will vary per tail light. Install tail light on car based on location before moving to the other tail lights.



12. Plug the resistors into the adapters.





13. Plug the adapters into the stock wiring. NOTE: the connectors look the same but are wired differently.





14. Plug the adapters into the new tail lights. Both plugs are the same, so orientation doesn't matter.



15. Mount the resistors to a metal surface. Secure excess wiring with cable ties.



16. Reinstall the grille and trim in the reverse order of removal. Use a compatible rivet or hardware of choice to replace the drilled rivets.

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
