### **FACTORY REAR BAR REMOVAL**

 Begin by raising the vehicle and supporting it with the proper safety equipment. Note: Never work on or under a vehicle that is not supported by the proper safety equipment.

2. Release the seat latch using the release handle located directly below the front seat cushion, then pull upward

on the seat to remove the seat. (See Photos 1 & 2) Note: Both driver and passenger sides must be removed to gain access to the bushing brackets on the OE anti-roll bar.

3. Turn the four plastic push clips 90 degrees to release the rear upper plastic valance, then, remove the valance as shown. (See Photos 3 & 4)

4. Turn the two push clips 90 degrees to release them, then, remove the four screws, two per side, to remove the storage console as shown. (See Photos 5, 6 & 7)

5. Turn the two plastic push clips 90 degrees to release the rear lower plastic valance, then, remove the valance as shown. (See Photos 8 & 9)

 Loosen and remove the hardware that secures the end links to both ends of the OE anti roll bar. Note: The OE hardware will be re-used. (See Photo 10)

7. Loosen and remove the OE hardware that secures the bushing brackets to the subframe, then, remove the bar from the vehicle as shown. Note: Be sure to note the orientation of the OE bar as the Eibach bar will be installed in the same orientation. (See Photos 11 & 12)

- 7. Reinstall the OE plastic covers and seats in reverse order of removal. (See Photos 21, 22, 23 & 24)
- 8. After road testing, double check all hardware to make sure everything is properly tightened and re-tighten if necessary.
