

INSTALLATION

- **1.** Park the vehicle on a hard, level surface and engage the emergency brake. Place chocks in front and behind wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.
- **2.** Raise the rear of vehicle to allow the axle to hang freely and support the frame using safety jack stands.
- **3.** Starting on the driver side, remove the existing factory bump stop from the underside of the frame by pulling and twisting the rubber tabs out of the frame brackets. You may need to use a flathead screwdriver to pry it out.
- **4.** Insert the top rear tab (end with the cut-out notch) at an angle into the rear part of the frame bracket. Slide the SumoSpring [ITEM A] to the rear so the tab is seated as far back into the frame bracket as possible. Then slide the SumoSpring forward so that the front tab slides into the front frame bracket. You may also use the flat head screwdriver to push the tabs in place if needed.
- **5.** The SumoSpring [ITEM A] should be fully seated and centered over axle looking similar to the original factory bump stop.
- **6.** Repeat steps 3 through 5 on the passenger side of your vehicle.
- **7.** Raise the vehicle, remove safety jack stands, and carefully lower vehicle to the hard surface. Remove the chocks in front and back of the rear wheels.
- **8.** Register the warranty for your SuperSprings International part. A warranty card can be found in the box your part came in.
