

VIAIR® PRESSURE REGULATOR



INSTALLATION

- 1. Drain air pressure completely from storage tank and air lines before attempting to install regulator.
- 2. Locate air flow directional arrows and securely install regulator using a threadlock compound with arrows pointing toward tool or work station.
- 3. Unlock the regulator adjusting knob by pulling knob upward or away from the regulator body.
- 4. Turn the regulator adjusting knob counter-clockwise until no load is on the regulating spring.
- 5. Securely install a gauge with appropriate pressure.
- 6. Turn on the air compressor to rebuild tank and line pressure. Rotate the regulator adjusting knob clockwise until the desired working pressure is achieved. Push the adjusting knob back down or toward the regulator body to lock in the desired working pressure.
- 7. We highly suggest the installation of a filtration device or water trap behind the regulator to remove moisture and prolong the life of the regulator and tools being operated.
- 8. The regulator is the most effective when installed as close as possible to the work station or tools being operated.







Description

The regulator maintains constant working pressure regardless of pressure fluctuations in the system or of air consumption.

Unpacking

After unpacking the regulator, carefully inspect for any shipping damage that may have occurred. Make sure to tighten fittings, bolts, etc., before putting into service. If damage is found please keep he packaging and report the damage to the dealer promptly.

Safety Guidelines

This manual contains information that is very important to know and understand. This information is provided for your SAFETY and to PREVENT EQUIPMENT PROBLEMS. To help recognize this information, observe the following symbols.

Danger

- Safety glasses must be worn during operation. Always work in a well ventilated area.
- Do not exceed the pressure rating of any component in the system.
- Protect air lines from damage and/or punctures.
- Check air lines and/or hoses for leaks or excessive wear before each use. Make sure all connections are secure.
- Keep all nuts, bolts and screws tight to ensure this equipment is in safe working condition.

Danger

This product is specifically designed for compressed air service ONLY. Use with any other material (liquid or gas) is a misapplication and not permitted. Use or injection of certain hazardous liquids or gases in the system (such as oxygen, alcohol or liquid petroleum gas) will harm the unit and result in a combustible condition or hazardous external leakage. Misapplication will void all warranties and manufacturer's responsibilities.

Danger

The relief flow capacity of this regulator is limited. Install additional pressure relief devices to alleviate over pressurized conditions. Written approval must be obtained from manufacturer if this device is to be used for life support systems or other non-industrial applications

Proper Installation

- Do not use on a compressed air system that exceeds the maximum air flow and pressure rating of this component.
- Locate and use the triangle
 "> " symbol stamped on the base during installation to achieve proper air flow.
- Install as close as possible to the air tools being used.
- Avoid installing in the path of direct sunshine, excessive heat, and hazardous chemicals or fumes.
- Use water traps and lubricators to prolong the life of your entire compressed air system.

LIMITED WARRANTY

- 1. DURATION: From the date of purchase by the original purchaser as follows: One Year.
- 2. WHAT IS COVERED UNDER THIS WARRANTY: Defects in material and workmanship which occur within the duration of the warranty period.
