






- 1. Remove the front and rear plastic roof accessory mounting covers on both sides of the vehicle. See Photo 1.
- 2. Use a 10mm socket to remove the factory bolts and brackets. See Photo 2.






- 3. Install two of the supplied shims at each of the factory mounting locations. See Photo 3.
- 4. Install the two front brackets (one notch) over the shims at the front of the vehicle using the supplied 8mm x 35mm bolt, 8mm lock washer, and 8mm flat washer. Tighten with a 13mm wrench. **See Photo 4.**





Install front brackets.

- 5. Install the two middle brackets (two notches) over the shims at the middle of the vehicle using the supplied 8mm x 35mm bolt, 8mm lock washer, and 8mm flat washer. Tighten with a 13mm wrench. **See Photo 5.**
- 6. Install the two rear brackets (three notches) over the shims at the rear of the vehicle using the supplied 8mm x 35mm bolt, 8mm lock washer, and 8mm flat washer. Tighten with a 13mm wrench. **See Photo 6.**









- Install the supplied 8mm x 16mm button head bolts, 8mm lock washers, and 8mm t-slot nuts as shown in Photo 7
  for all six brackets.
- Slide the two 81" rail over the t-slots of the brackets. Secure with a 5mm Allen wrench. Do not fully tighten. See Photo 8.






- 9. Install the corner joints into the two 40.3" sections of rail. Tighten using a 4mm Allen wrench. See Photo 9.
- 10. Lift the short sections of rail to the front and rear ends of the long rail. Attach the corner joints to the long rails using a 4mm Allen wrench. **See Photo 10.**





- 11. Assemble the cross brace brackets as shown in Photo 11.
- 12. Slide the cross brace bracket to the cross brace using the wider side of the bracket. Place cross brace in desired location and tighten the t-slot nuts using a 5mm Allen wrench. **See Photo 12.**
- 13. Adjust final fitment to desired location and tighten all hardware.










### **Tie-Down Bracket Installation**

1. Install the supplied 8mm x 16mm button head bolts, 8mm lock washers, and 8mm t-slot nuts into the tie-down bracket. See Photos 1 & 2





- 2. Slide the T-slot nuts into the T rail and place each bracket in the desired location. See Photo 3.
- 3. Tighten each bolt using a 5mm Allen. See Photo 4.







### POST INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Check all fasteners for proper torque. Check to ensure for adequate clearance between all rotating, mobile, fixed, and heated members. Verify clearance between exhaust and brake lines, fuel lines, fuel tank, floorboards, and wiring harness.
- 2. All kit components must be retightened at 500 miles and then every 300 miles after installation. Periodically check all hardware for tightness.
- 3. Install "Warning to Driver" decal on sun visor.
