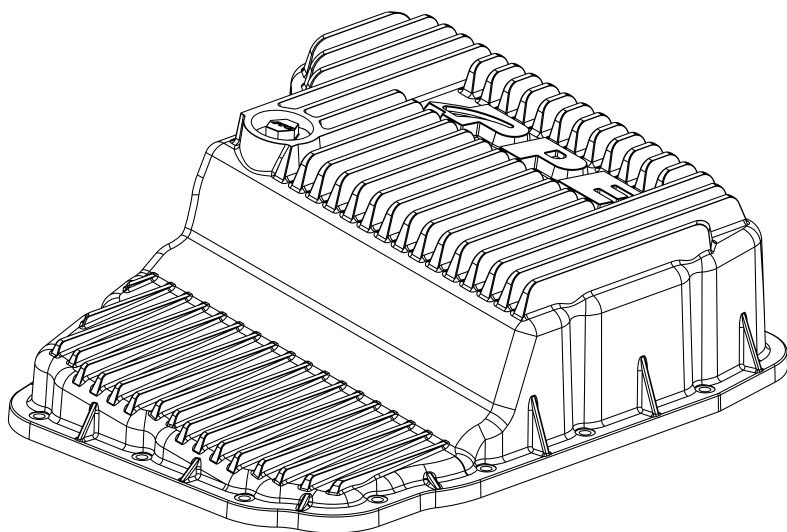
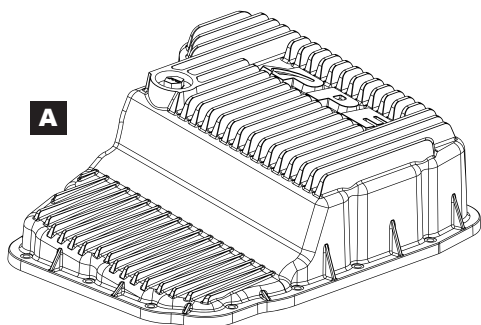

Break-In Service Recommendation:

For new vehicles, early fluid changes help clear out normal break-in particles, preventing them from circulating and causing additional wears. We recommend changing engine oil at 500 miles, transmission fluid and rear differential oil at 2,000 miles. During each service, replace with fresh fluid, clean magnets if equipped, inspect the debris caught by the magnets, and replace filters where applicable. Always follow OEM service manuals and any guidance from your installer or builder. The same break-in service is also recommended for rebuilds, fresh installs, and major repairs.

INSTALLATION

1. Remove all but two (loosen only) factory transmission pan bolts to partially drain the transmission fluid from the mating surface
2. Remove the last two bolts and remove the factory transmission pan. Watch out for spillage.
3. Wipe off any fluid residuals from the valve body and the mating surface. **(Fig. 1)**



4. Unbolt and remove the original fluid screen filter. Note that the seal might remain stuck inside the fluid pickup tube, make sure you remove the seal. Then install a new transmission fluid screen filter (SKU 228052186) and secure with the same bolt that was removed. **(Fig. 2)**



5. Remove the original spin-on transmission filter and install the included PPE spin-on filter SKU 228052150. **(Fig. 3)**



6. If reusing the original gasket, thoroughly clean before installing pan. For best results, use the PPE Compound Gasket SKU 228052004. **(Fig. 4)**

7. Install the transmission pan together with the gasket. Install all bolts hand-tight. Then tighten all bolts in a crossing pattern to 108 lb-in. **(Fig. 5)**



8. Refill transmission fluid through the dipstick tube inside the engine bay.
