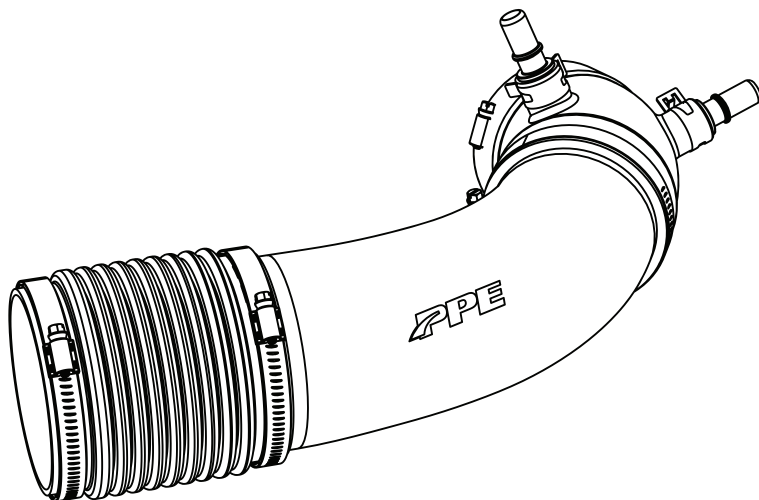

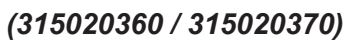

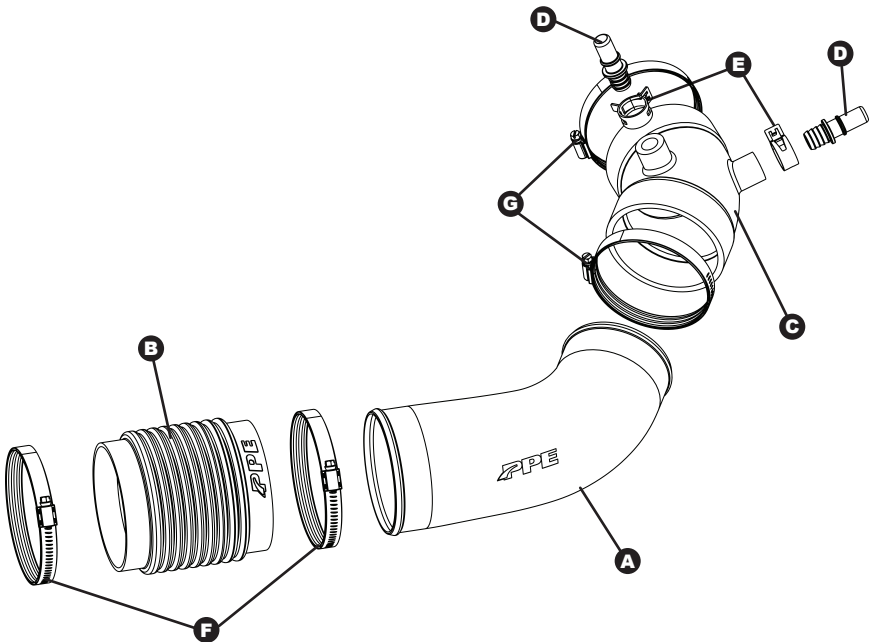

INSTALLATION

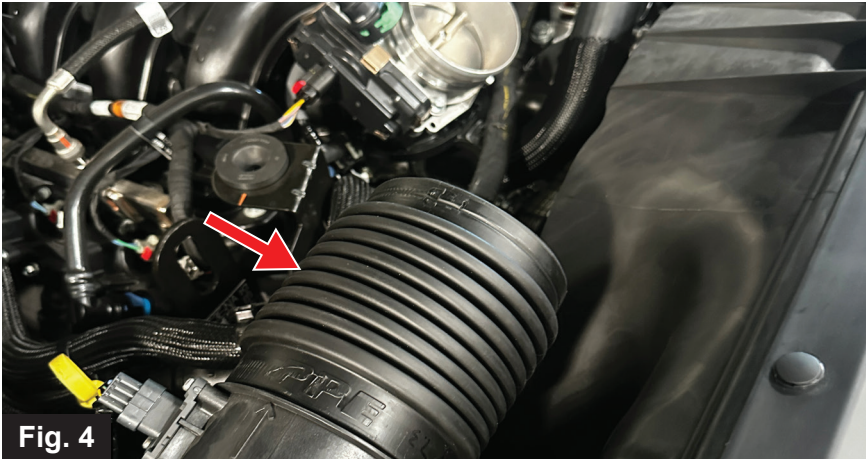
1. Turn the vehicle off and allow time to cool down before installation.
2. Loosen the factory hose clamps. Disconnect the two (2) hose connections on the factory intake tube. **(Fig. 1) (Fig. 2)**



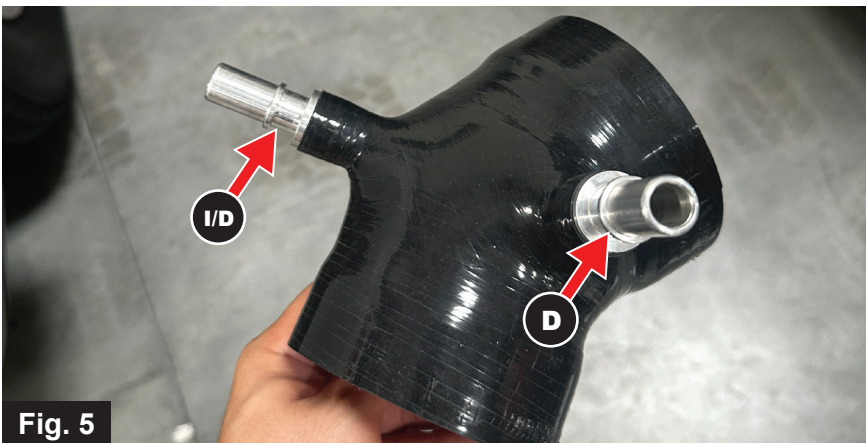
3. Remove the factory intake tube. **(Fig. 3)**



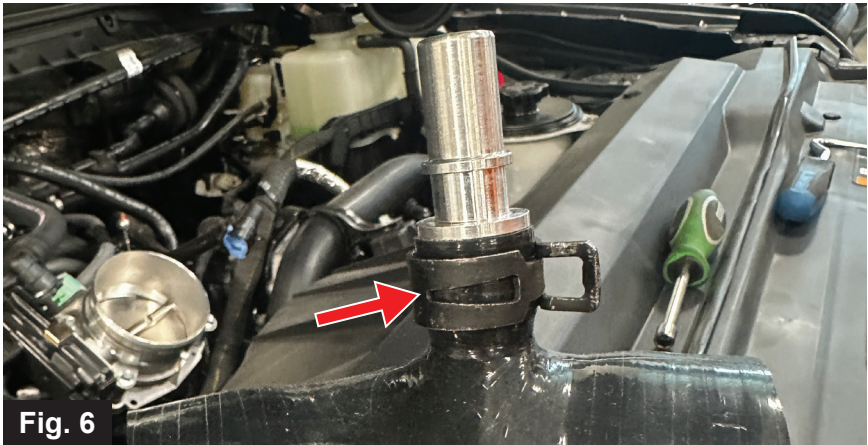
4. Install the supplied flexible coupler **(B)**. **(Fig. 4)**



5. Install the supplied aluminum fittings **(I),(D)** into the elbow coupler **(C)**. **(Fig. 5)**



6. Install the spring clamps **(E),(J)**. **(Fig. 6)**



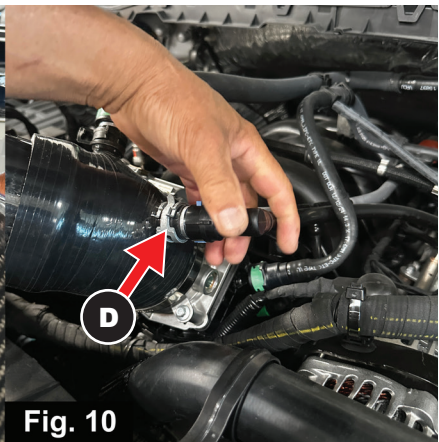
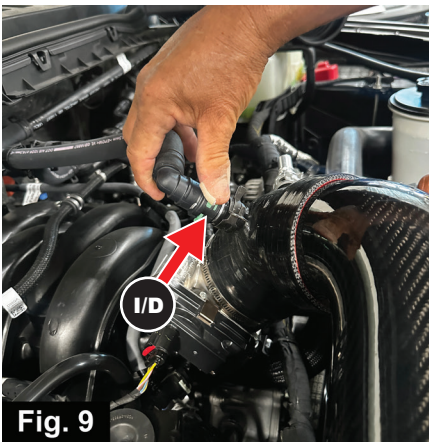
7. Install the elbow coupler **(C)** onto the throttle body with the supplied hose clamp **(H),(G)**. Do not tighten the hose clamp. **(Fig. 7)**



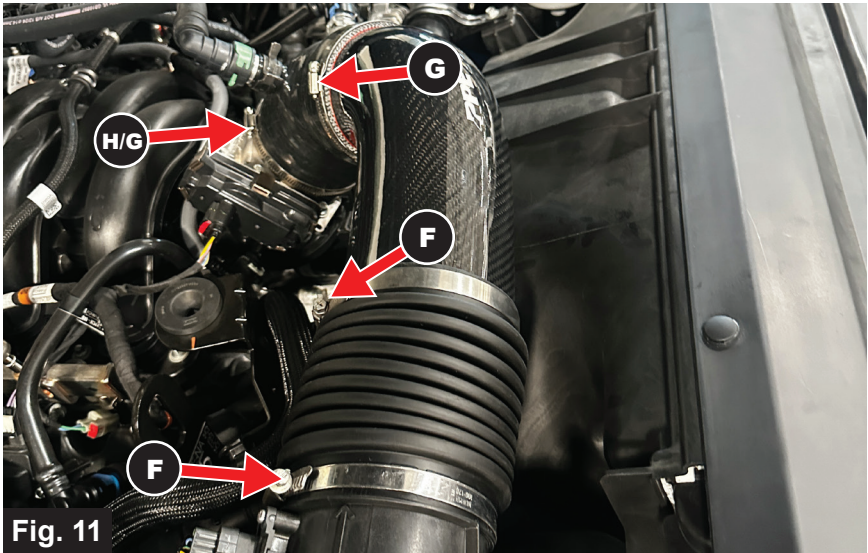
8. Install the PPE intake tube **(A)** into the flexible coupler **(B)** and elbow coupler **(C)**. **(Fig. 8)**



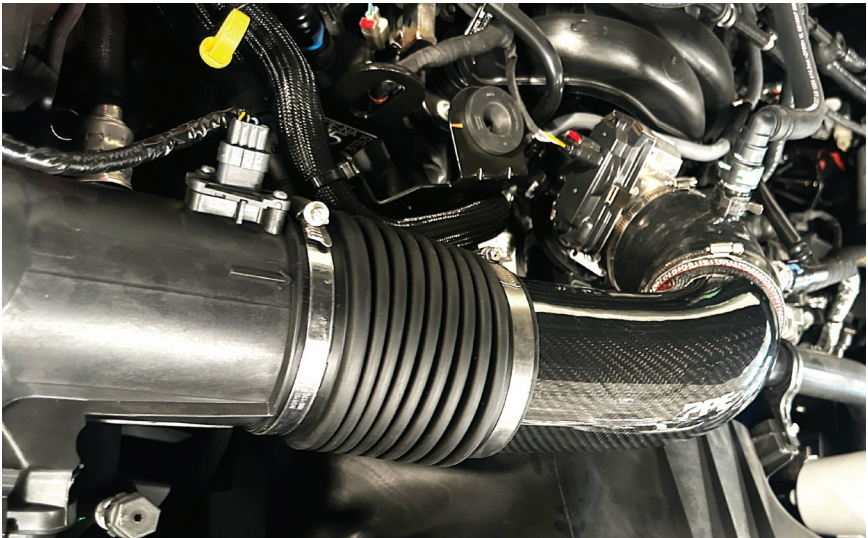
9. Reconnect the two factory hose connections into the aluminum fittings **(I),(D)**. **(Fig. 9) (Fig. 10)**



10. Install and tighten the supplied hose clamps (F),(G),(H). (Fig. 11)
